Brief About Uttarakhand:

A land of myths and mountains, Devbhoomi Uttarakhand, is one of the most beautiful states of India. Snow-capped Himalayan peaks, serpentine rivers, revered temples, quaint villages, vibrant culture, and World Heritage Sites, Uttarakhand's sheer natural beauty and diversity beckon travelers from across the world.

Uttarakhand is a state in the northern part of India. It is often referred to as the "Devbhumi" (literally 'Land of the Gods') due to its religious significance and numerous Hindu temples and pilgrimage sites found throughout the state. As a result, religious tourism forms a major portion of tourism in the state. Uttarakhand is known for the natural environment of the Himalayas.

Uttarakhand was formed on the 9th of November 2000 as the 27th State of India, when it was carved out of northern Uttar Pradesh. Located at the foothills of the Himalayan mountain ranges, it is largely a hilly State, having international boundaries with China (Tibet) in the north and Nepal in the east. It is known for its beautiful Garhwali and Kumaoni culture. The various traditions, religions, fairs, festivals, folk dances, and music are what distinctly separate them. Uttarakhand is only the state with Sanskrit as the official language.

Day 1: Delhi – Nainital

Arrival at Delhi Airport /Railway Station. Upon arrival, meet and greet with our tour escort and proceed to Nainital (325kms./8hrs.). Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel.

Day 2: Nainital

Enjoy Snow View point by cable car at the foothills of Himalayas. Visit Chidyaghar and Hanumangarhi temple - religious centre and a gorgeous spot well known for its Sunset, Bhimtal, Naukuchialtal, Mall Road.

Day 3: Nainital – Ranikhet

Morning departure to Ranikhet(70 kms./2hrs.). Enroute visit Army Museum, Chaubatia garden, Rama Mandir. Upon arrival, check into the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

Day 4: Ranikhet – Kasauni

Morning departure to Kausani(76kms/3hrs.) to spend a quiet day in the lap of nature with a stunning view of the Himalayan ranges. Afternoon picnic near the River Kosi and spend the day exploring the beauty of nature.

Day 5: Kasauni

After breakfast, half day sightseeing of Baijnath and Bageshwar. Its an ancient and small town famous for its magnificent stone idol of the Hindu goddess Parvati. Mahatma Gandhi called this place the 'Switzerland of India', due to similarity in landscape.

Day 6: Kasauni – Delhi

Morning drive to Delhi(391 kms./7hrs.). Arrival at Delhi in the evening . Board Flight/Train for return journey.
