Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - 07:30Hrs - Departure from Karol Bagh, Delhi to Haridwar (205 Km/approx. 5 hrs)

Board the vehicle from Karolbagh Delhi and proceed to Haridwar. Here your Char Dham Yatra package will be started. Afternoon check in to the hotel and post lunch proceed to Hari-Ki-Pauri, Mansa Devi Temple and enjoy evening Ganga Aarti. Overnight at hotel.

Night Stay - Haridwar

Day 2 - 06:00Hrs - Haridwar - Rishikesh-Barkot

After having a healthy breakfast check out from the hotel and proceed to Rishikesh (24 Km), visit Shivananda Ashram, Ram jhoola, Swarg Ashram, Geeta Ashram, Lakshman Jhoola. Proceed to Barkot via Vikasnagar (250 km / 7-8 hrs.). Enroute enjoy lunch. Upon arrival, check into your Hotel. Overnight Stay.

Night Stay - Barkot

Day 3 - 05:00Hrs - Barkot - Yamunotri - Barkot

This Char Dham Yatra package has interesting places including Hanumanchatti. Departure to Hanumanchatti (32 km / 1.5 hrs). Later take a local jeep to Janakichatti to shorten your trek by 5 Km. Proceed to Yamunotri temple by walk / pony / doli. (Approximate charges for both ways by Yamunotri: from Janakichetti parking area trek 6 km Horse charges: 2500/- Doli charges: 8000/-. Return to Barkot. Overnight stay.

Day 4 - 07:00Hrs - Barkot - Uttarkashi

Today after breakfast check out (10:00 hrs) from the hotel and keep your luggage at reception. Leisure time till noon. Post Lunch, Proceed to Uttarkashi (100 Km. / 4 Hrs). Upon arrival, Check into hotel.

Night Stay - Uttarkashi

Day 5 - 05:00Hrs - Uttarkashi - Gangotri - Uttarkashi

Departure to Gangotri (100 Km. / 5 hrs). Upon arrival at Gangotri, take a Holy Dip in the sacred Ganges, Perform Pooja and return to Uttarkashi. (Gangotri Yamunotri has an important role in the Yatra). Overnight stay.

Meals - Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Night Stay – Uttarkashi

Day 6 - 07:00Hrs - Uttarkashi - Rampur

Post breakfast, check out the Hotel and proceed to Srinagar (150 km / 5.5hrs), have lunch and then drive Rampur (100 km / 4.5 hrs) upon arrival, check into your Hotel. Char Dham Yatra package has more to go. Overnight Stay.

Night Stay - Rampur

Day 7 - 04:00Hrs - Rampur-Kedarnath-Rampur

Early hours proceed to Sonprayag (4 km), then to Gaurikund (5 km) by Govt. Jeep and later proceed to Kedarnath (17 km) by pony / Doli / walk (Kedarnath: from Gaurikund trek 17 km Horse charges: 5300/-Doli charges: 11000/-). After Darshan & Pooja at Temple, return to Rampur. Overnight stay.

Night Stay - Rampur

Day 8 - 13:00Hrs - Rampur - Pipalkoti

Today after breakfast check out (10:00 hrs) from the hotel and keep your luggage at reception. Leisure till noon. Later drive to Pipalkoti (160 km / 6 hrs), Check into your Hotel. Overnight Stay.

Meals - Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Night Stay - Pipalkoti

Day 9 - 08:00Hrs - Pipalkoti-Badrinath

Morning after breakfast, check out the Hotel and drive to Badrinath (79 km / 3.5 hrs), Check into your Hotel. Saraswati Pushkar Yatra-2025, 15th May to 26th May 2025 can also be covered in this package. Later visit to Mana Village (3 km), the last Village before the Tibetan border and return to hotel. Evening Darshan of Shri Badrinath Ji. Overnight Stay.

Meals - Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Night Stay - Badrinath

Day 10 - 08:00Hrs - Badrinath - Srinagar

Morning visit to Temple/perform the rituals, if any and then return to hotel. Check out the Hotel and proceed to Srinagar ($190 \, \text{km} / 7 \, \text{hrs}$). Enroute Lunch at Pipalkoti. Arrive Srinagar, Check into your Hotel. Overnight Stay.

Night Stay - Srinagar

Day 11 - 07:00Hrs - Srinagar - Delhi

Morning after breakfast, check out the Hotel and depart to Delhi (370 km /approx. 8 hrs), enroute lunch at Haridwar. Later proceed to Delhi. Hope you enjoyed this Char Dham Yatra package.

- 2. The helicopter tickets are managed by IRCTC and will be booked on their website on your behalf. The actual fare will be declared around one month prior to the departure date. The above fare has been calculated at 9,400/- (as per 2025 rates), Ex-Sersi & Phata only. If there is any increase or decrease in the fare, it will be charged accordingly as a supplement. The Helicopter services operate from Sersi / Phata / Guptkashi, and the fare will be charged as per the actual amount applicable at the time of booking.
- 3. Please note that due to the mandatory registration for Yatra at Rishikesh on the 2nd day, the schedule may be delayed, as the process could take around 6–7 hours because of long queues. We sincerely appreciate your understanding.
- 4. Due to heavy traffic conditions, our buses are now not allowed to local places i.e. from Kedarnath base point Rampur / Sitapur & Haridwar, Rishikesh. pilgrims are advised to take the assistance of their "tour

manager" for the local transfers by jeep/autos to helipad / pony stand etc. on a direct payment basis.

PLACES COVERED

Uttarkashi

Uttarkashi, which means Kashi of the north, is a holy town in Uttarkashi. Uttarkashi is situated on the banks of river Bhagirathi, 1352 m above sea level. Uttarkashi is home to a number of ashrams and ancient temples along with the Nehru Institute of Mountaineering. The name of the town reflects its similarity to the city of Kashi, officially known Varanasi. Similar to Varanasi, town of Uttarkashi is situated on the Ganges and lies next to a hill named Varun Parvat, on confluence of two rivers Varuna and Asi. It also has a ghat called Manikarnika Ghat and has a temple dedicated to Shiva (Kashi Vishwanath Temple) in the center of the town.

Yamunotri

Yamunotri is the origin of the Yamuna River and the holy seat of the Goddess Yamuna in Hinduism. It is situated in the Garhwal Himalayas and located approximately 30 kilometers North of Uttarkashi. It is one of the four sites in India's Chhota Char Dham pilgrimage and source of the river Yamuna. Yamunotri is the westernmost shrine in the Garhwal Himalayas, perched atop a flank of Bandar Poonch Parvat. The chief attraction at Yamunotri is the temple devoted to the Goddess Yamuna. The temple of Yamuna, on the left bank of the Yamuna, was constructed by Maharaja Pratap Shah of Tehri Garhwal, which is is made of black marble.

Gangotri

Gangotri is a Hindu pilgrim town on the banks of the river Bhagirathi on the Greater Himalayan Range, at a height of 3,100. Gangotri, the origin and seat of the goddess Ganga, is one of the four sites in the Char Dham pilgrimage circuit. The river is called Bhagirathi at the source and acquires the name Ganga from Devprayag onwards where it meets another river Alaknanda. The origin of the holy river is at Gaumukh, set in the Gangotri Glacier. According to Hindu mythology, Goddess Ganga took the form of a river to absolve the sins of King Bhagiratha's predecessors.

Haridwar

Haridwar is an important pilgrimage city, companioned by river Ganges. The river Ganges after flowing for 253 kilometres from its source at Gaumukh, enters the Indo-Gangetic Plains of North India for the first time at Haridwar, which gave the city its ancient name, Gangadwára. Haridwar is viewed as one of the seven holiest places to Hindus. Amidst the Kumbha Mela, millions of pilgrims, devotees, and tourists congregate in Haridwar to perform ritualistic bathing on the banks of the river Ganges to wash away their sins. Brahma Kund is located at Har ki Pauri and is considered to be the most sacred ghat of Haridwar.

Rishikesh

Rishikesh is located in the foothills of the Himalayas and is known as 'The Gateway to the Himalayas'. Rishikesh is located about 25 km north of holy city, Haridwar. Legends state that Lord Rama did penance here for killing Ravana, and Lakshmana, his younger brother, crossed the river Ganges, at a point, where the present 'Lakshman Jhula' bridge stands today. The sacred river Ganges flows through Rishikesh and leaves the Shivalik Mountains in the Himalayas, flowing out into the plains of northern India. Several temples, ancient with new are found along the banks of the Ganges in Rishikesh.

Badrinath

Badrinath is a Hindu holy town that is the most important of the four sites in India's Char Dham pilgrimage. Badrinath was re-established as a major pilgrimage site by Adi Shankara in the ninth century and in recent years; its popularity has increased significantly, with an estimated 600,000 pilgrims visiting during the 2006 season, against 90,676 in 1961. Badrinath has been mentioned as a holy place in Hindu scriptures for thousands of years. According to the Bhagavata Purana (3.4.22),"There in Badrikashram the supreme being

(Vishnu), in his incarnation as the sages Nara and Narayana, had been undergoing great penance since time immemorial for the welfare of all living entities."

Pipalkoti

Pipalkoti is a small and scenic town situated at 17kms after Chamoli on National Highway- 58. Pipalkoti acts a relaxation point for people traveling to Badrinath, Hemkund Sahib and famous Valley of Flowers. Pipalkoti is nestled amidst lush green mountains and terraced fields and provides delightful views of the snow clad mountains in addition to green hills all around. The place is also known for its restaurants and eat-outs. Travelers can relax at Pipalkoti, getting pleasure from the picturesque views and delicious food.

Kedarnath

Kedarnath is a Hindu holy town and the most remote of the four Char Dham sites. Kedarnath is located in the Himalayas, about 3584m above sea level near the head of river Mandakini. The site is flanked by breathtaking snow- capped peaks. Kedarnath hosts one of the holiest Hindu temples and the Kedarnath Temple is a popular destination for Hindu pilgrims from all over the world. Kedarnath has been in existence from the Mahabharata era when the Pandavas are supposed to have pleased Lord Shiva by doing penance, here. There are 2 ways to reach Kedarnath, one of them is via foot for a steep 14 km trek through a paved path and second way is by helicopter service.

Rampur

Rampur is located in the Ranikhet tehsil of Almora district. It is located 50 KM towards North from District head quarters Almora and 158 KM from State capital Dehradun. Rampur is surrounded by Dwarahat Tehsil towards South, Syaldey Tehsil towards west, Gairsain Tehsil towards North, Bhikiyasain Tehsil towards South. Almora, Nainital, Ramnagar, Pauri are the nearby Cities to Rampur. This Place is in the border of the Almora District and Chamoli District. Chamoli District Gairsain is North towards this place. Hindi is the Local Language here.
