DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1 (07:30 Hrs.): Delhi \rightarrow Haridwar (205 km / Approx. 5 hrs.)

Board the vehicle from Hotel Southern, Karol Bagh, New Delhi and proceed to Haridwar. Afternoon check into the hotel. Post lunch, visit Har-Ki-Pauri, Mansa Devi Temple and enjoy the evening Ganga Aarti. Return to the hotel. Overnight stay in Haridwar.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 2 (07:00 Hrs.): Haridwar → Rishikesh → Barkot (Approx. 250 km / 7–8 hrs.)

After early breakfast, check out the hotel and proceed to Rishikesh (24 km). Visit Shivananda Ashram, Ram Jhoola, Swarg Ashram, Geeta Ashram, Janki Setu. Later proceed to Barkot via Vikasnagar. Arrive Barkot and check into the hotel. Overnight Stay at Barkot.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 3 (05:00 Hrs.): Barkot → Yamunotri → Barkot

Early morning drive to Jankichatti (45 km / 2.5 hrs.). Arrive Janki Chatti and then start trek to Yamunotri Temple (6 km) by walk / pony / doli. Approx Rates Per Person (Both Ways): Pony: ₹2500/- |Doli: ₹8000/- (Rates subject to change as per local union.) Arrive at Yamunotri, and may take a Holy Bath in Yamuna River (Yamunotri is the Birthplace of River Yamuna). After the Holy Bath, proceed for Yamunotri Temple darshan. Later, return to Janki Chatti and drive back to Barkot. Overnight Stay at Barkot.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Day 4 (08:00 Hrs.): Barkot → Haridwar (Approx. 250 km / 7–8 hrs.)

After breakfast, check out the hotel and drive back to Haridwar. Arrive Haridwar and check into the hotel. Overnight Stay at Haridwar.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 5 (08:00 Hrs.): Haridwar → Delhi Drop (225 km / Approx. 4-5 hrs.)

After breakfast, check out the hotel and proceed to Delhi (Hotel Southern, Karol Bagh). Arrive in the Afternoon. Tour concludes.

- 2. Please note that due to the mandatory registration (Green Card) for Yatra at Rishikesh, the schedule may be delayed, as the process could take around 6–7 hours because of long queues. We sincerely appreciate your understanding.
- 3. Local sightseeing in Rishikesh will have to be covered by auto-rickshaws on direct payment basis, as buses are not permitted beyond the parking area.
- 4. Our buses are allowed only upto Janki Chatti. Later, Pilgrims are advised to take the assistance of their "tour manager" for proceeding to Yamunotri Dham by Doly / Pony / Walk etc. on a direct payment basis.

PLACES COVERED

Haridwar

Haridwar is an important pilgrimage city, companioned by river Ganges. The river Ganges after flowing for 253 kilometres from its source at Gaumukh, enters the Indo-Gangetic Plains of North India for the first time at Haridwar, which gave the city its ancient name, Gangadwára. Haridwar is viewed as one of the seven holiest places to Hindus. Amidst the Kumbha Mela, millions of pilgrims, devotees, and tourists congregate in Haridwar to perform ritualistic bathing on the banks of the river Ganges to wash away their sins. Brahma Kund is located at Har ki Pauri and is considered to be the most sacred ghat of Haridwar.

Rishikesh

Rishikesh is located in the foothills of the Himalayas and is known as 'The Gateway to the Himalayas'. Rishikesh is located about 25 km north of holy city, Haridwar. Legends state that Lord Rama did penance here for killing Ravana, and Lakshmana, his younger brother, crossed the river Ganges, at a point, where the present 'Lakshman Jhula' bridge stands today. The sacred river Ganges flows through Rishikesh and leaves the Shivalik Mountains in the Himalayas, flowing out into the plains of northern India. Several temples, ancient with new are found along the banks of the Ganges in Rishikesh.

Yamunotri

Yamunotri is the origin of the Yamuna River and the holy seat of the Goddess Yamuna in Hinduism. It is situated in the Garhwal Himalayas and located approximately 30 kilometers North of Uttarkashi. It is one of the four sites in India's Chhota Char Dham pilgrimage and source of the river Yamuna. Yamunotri is the westernmost shrine in the Garhwal Himalayas, perched atop a flank of Bandar Poonch Parvat. The chief attraction at Yamunotri is the temple devoted to the Goddess Yamuna. The temple of Yamuna, on the left bank of the Yamuna, was constructed by Maharaja Pratap Shah of Tehri Garhwal, which is is made of black marble.
