DETAILED ITINERARY		

Day 1 (10:00 Hrs.): Delhi → Vrindavan (185 km / 4 hrs.)

Board the vehicle from Hotel Southern, Karol Bagh, New Delhi and proceed to Vrindavan. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and later continue to Mathura for local sightseeing. Visit Shri Krishna Janmabhoomi Temple, Dwarkadhish Temple, Vishram Ghat and other important points of interest. After completing the visits, return to Vrindavan. Overnight Stay at Vrindavan.

Meals: Lunch & Dinner

Day 2 (06:00 Hrs.): Vrindavan – Yamuna Bath & Local Visits

Early morning, proceed for a Holy Bath in the Yamuna River. After the bath, continue with the local visits in Vrindavan, covering Banke Bihari Temple, ISKCON Temple, Prem Mandir, Nidhivan & Seva Kunj. Overnight stay in Vrindavan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 3 (07:00 Hrs.): Vrindavan – Gokul – Govardhan Visits – Delhi Drop (215 Kms / 5 hrs.)

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to Gokul (25 Kms) for sightseeing, including Chintaharan Mahadev, Raman Reti, Brahmand Ghat, and Chaurasi Khamba. Later, continue to Govardhan for visits to Govardhan Parikrama, Kusum Sarovar, and Mansi Ganga. After completing the sightseeing, depart for Delhi. Tour Concludes.

PLACES COVERED

Vrindavan

Vrindavan, situated on the banks of the Yamuna River, is considered the spiritual heart of the Braj region and is one of the holiest places for devotees of Krishna. It is the sacred town where Lord Krishna spent his childhood and youth, engaging in his playful leelas (divine pastimes) with his supreme consort Radha and the gopis (cowherd maidens). Vrindavan is known as the "Forest of Tulsi" and is home to thousands of temples, including the famous Banke Bihari Temple, the magnificent Prem Mandir, and the ISKCON Temple, each embodying the intense devotion (Bhakti) and eternal love for the divine couple, Radha and Krishna.

Mathura

Mathura is revered as one of the seven Sapta Puri (seven holiest cities) in Hinduism and holds supreme importance as the birthplace of Lord Krishna. The main site of pilgrimage is the Shri Krishna Janmabhoomi, built around the prison cell where he is traditionally believed to have been born. Located on the western bank of the Yamuna, Mathura is also central to the history of ancient India, flourishing as a major center for art, culture, and trade under various empires. Devotees perform rituals at the numerous ghats along the river, with the Vishram Ghat—where Krishna is believed to have rested after defeating the evil King Kansa—being the most sacred.

Gokul

Gokul is a small, quiet town situated across the Yamuna from Mathura, holding immense significance as the place where the infant Krishna was secretly raised by his foster parents, Nanda and Yashoda, to protect him from Kansa's wrath. It is the site of many of Krishna's earliest and most charming childhood leelas, such as the demonstration of the entire universe in his mouth to Mother Yashoda at Brahmand Ghat, and his playful activities at Raman Reti (the sacred sand playground). Gokul embodies the innocence and intimate parental affection (Vatsalya Prema) associated with baby Krishna, making it a place of deep emotional connection for devotees.
