ITINERARY

DAY 1: Arrive Bhubaneshwar

Arrive Bhubaneswar, the Capital city of the modern State and the ancient Kingdom of Kalinga. You will be met upon arrival & transfer to the hotel. Afternoon proceed to the Local visits Lingaraj Temple dedicated to Lord Shiva built in the 11th century, proceed to Mukteswara temple built in the 10th century known for its sculpted tales from the Panchatantra carved on it, the temple is a magnificent example of Odishan architecture continue to The Rajarani temple set in picturesque surrounding is noted for its intricate carvings of floral, animal and human figures built in the 11th Century. Rest of the evening is at leisure for individual activities.

DAY 2: Bhubaneswar-Biraja Devi-Bhubaneswar-Udayagiri-Khandagiri-Bhubaneswar

Post breakfast Departure to Jajpur(100 Kms /2hrs) enroute visit very old Jagannath culture of Chhattala on arrival at Jajpur visit Biraja Devi Temple (One of the Shakti Pithas of Asthadasa) in the bank of Baitarani and it is called Navi Gaya. Later drive back to Bhubaneswar and Also visit the Jain Caves, Khandagiri & Udayagiri

Night Stay: Bhubaneshwar

DAY 3: Bhubaneswar-Pipili-Raghurajpur -Konark-Pipli-Puri

After breakfast check out hotel and dep. to Puri (65 kms /1:30 hrs) enroute visit Dhauli. The battleground of Kalinga war during 3rd century BC, which transformed Emperor Ashoka into Dharmashoka. Later proceed to Pipili and Raghurajpur Handicraft Villages and Later you will visit Konarak world heritage site. The temple chariot of the Sun God on the sands of Bay of Bengal is a 13th Century architectural marvel. It is designed as a celestial chariot of Sun God, complete with twelve pairs of wheel and seven horses. This legendary temple has sculptures of great beauty covering all aspects of life. It is most famous for its erotic art Later drive to Puri and proceed to your hotel.

Night Stay: Puri

DAY 4 : Lord Jagannath Temple Visit and Chilika Lake

Early morning you can visit the Lord Jagannath temple and witness the Mangala Arti Darshan. Post breakfast proceed to Chilika lagoon to have the view of dolphins by boat cruise and back to Puri and have a fun at Puri Beach in the Evening.

DAY 5: Puri-Maa Tara Tarani Temple –Berhampur

Morning after breakfast, checkout the Hotel & proceed to Berhampur (180 Kms / 3.5 hrs), enroute visit Maa Tara Tarani Temple (Purnesvari Maa Tara Tarini on Purnagiri hills is worshiped as the Breast Shrine Sthana Peetha) of Adi Shakti. The temple is one of the oldest pilgrimage centers of Mother goddesses and one of the four major ancient Tantra Peethas and Shakti Peethas in India. On arrival at Berhampur, Check into the hotel & evening free for shopping. Overnight stay.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Night Stay: Berhampur

DAY 6: Berhampur - Srimukhalingam – Srikakulam

Morning after breakfast, checkout the hotel & proceed to Srimukhalingam (146 kms / 3 hrs), Visit Srimukhalingeswara Temple and then drive to Srikakulam(50 kms / 1 hr), Check into your hotel. Later proceed to Arasavalli Surya Narayana Swamy Temple (The temple is one of the two major temples who worship Lord Surya in India, According to the ' Sthalapuram ' of the temple, Lord Devendra found this temple and installed the existing idol of the sun God commonly known as Lord Suryanarayana Swamy Varu) and then drive to Srikurmam (20 kms / 0.4 hr), Visit Sri Kurmanathaswamy Temple (Srikurmam is the only Indian temple in the world where Vishnu is worshiped in his Kurma avatar). Return back to hotel. Overnight stay.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Night Stay: Srikakulam

DAY 7: Srikakulam- Visakhapatnam

After breakfast, checkout the Hotel and proceed to Visakhapatnam (130 kms / 3 hrs), on arrival check into the Hotel. Later proceed to Visit Simhachalam Temple (famous Vishnu Temple). Evening Visit Kailasagiri, Rushikonda Beach and return to hotel. Overnight stay.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Night Stay: Visakhapatnam

DAY 8: Visakhapatnam - Araku Valley – Borra Caves-Visakhapatnam

Post breakfast, proceed to visit Araku valley, Padmapuram Gardens, Tribal Museum, Ananthagiri Coffee plantations, Galikonda view Point, Borra Caves & back to Visakhapatnam. Overnight stay.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Night Stay: Visakhapatnam

DAY 9: Visakhapatnam - Annavaram- Visakhapatnam

After breakfast, proceed to Annavaram (115 kms / 2.5 hrs), Have a Darshan of Sri Satyanarayana Swamy Varu. After darshan, back to Annavaram/Visakhapatnam Railway Station/Airport for your onward journey with the sweet memories of Odisha & Andhra Tour.

Bhubaneswar



Bhubaneswar, the capital of Orissa has a history of over 3000 years starting with the Mahamegha-bahana Chedi dynasty. The dynasty had Sisupalgarh near present-day Bhubaneswar as their capital. Bhubaneswar has been known by many names such as Toshali, Kalinga Nagari, Nagar Kalinga, Ekamra Kanan, otherwise known as the Temple City of India. Bhubaneswar literally means the Lord (Eeswar) of the Universe (Bhuban), a center of economic and religious importance in the region today. Bhubaneswar's possession of magnificent sculptures and architectural heritage make this one of the great religious centers of Orissa.

Puri



Puri is situated on the Bay of Bengal, south of the state capital Bhubaneswar. It is also known as Jagannath Puri after the 11th century Jagannath Temple located in the city and is a holy city of the Hindus as a part of the Char Dham pilgrimages. According to Hindu teachings, a pilgrimage of the temples is not considered complete without a journey to Puris it is endowed with one of the best beaches for swimming in India and is therefore also a popular beach resort. Puri, the holy land of Lord Jagannath, has many names and is mentioned in Puranas as Srikshetra, Shankhakshetra, Neelachala, Dhama, Purusottama Kshetra, Purusottama Puri and Jagannath Puri. The word "Puri" means 'town', or 'city'.

Konark



Konark in Puri district on the Bay of Bengal is the site of the 13th-century Sun Temple (also known as the Black Pagoda), built in black granite by King Narasimhadeva-I (AD 1236-1264) of the Eastern Ganga Dynasty. The temple is a World Heritage Site, which takes the form of the chariot of Surya (Arka), the Sun God, and is heavily decorated with stone carving. The entire complex was designed in the form of a huge chariot drawn by seven spirited horses. The entrance is guarded by two lions, which are each shown crushing a war elephant as each elephant in turn lies on top of a human body. The temple symbolises the majestic stride of the Sun god and is where the temple dancers used to perform dances in homage to the Sun god.

Araku valley



Araku Valley is a hill station in Alluri Sitharama Raju district in the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh, lying 111 km west of Visakhapatnam city. It is a valley in the Eastern Ghats inhabited by different tribes, mainly Araku Tribes.

Visakha Museum



The Visakha Museum is primarily a historical one that houses the historical treasures of the ‘Vizagapatam’ district of the Madras Presidency of the pre-independence era. It is located on an Old Dutch bungalow on the RK Beach. Some of the notable items on display here are – A collection of photographs of Gandhiji, especially the ones clicked on his visit to Vishakhapatnam, A 250-lb bomb dropped by the Japanese during the World War II that never exploded, A 30” search light reflector used by Vasco-da-Gama’s Ship on his maiden voyage to India, Ancient armoury and life size portraits of the royal family of Vizianagram & Bobbili.

Araku Valley



Araku Valley is a hill station in Visakhapatnam. It is a beautiful valley in the Eastern Ghats inhabited by different types of tribes and is one of the less commercialized tourist destinations in South India. Valley is located 114 km from Vishakhapatnam, close to the Orissa state border. The Anantagiri and Sunkarimetta Reserved Forest which are part of Araku Valley are rich in biodiversity, surrounded by mountains like Galikonda, Raktakonda, Sunkarimetta and Chitamogondi. Araku is popular for its famous coffee plantations as India’s first tribal growers’ organic coffee brand was launched in the Araku Valley, itself.

Annaram



Annaram is a temple town on the banks of the Pampa River. It is located in Kakinada district of the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. The village has the temple of Veera Venkata Satyanarayana, a form of Vishnu on the Ratnagiri Hill. It is 18 km away from Tuni city.
