DAY 1: Arrival Guwahati

Arrive at Guwahati Airport / Railway Station, check into your Hotel. Later visit the famous Maa Kamakhya Temple on the Nilachal Hills (10 kms.) and Sri Sankardeva Kalakshetra. Overnight Stay in Guwahati.

DAY 2: Guwahati- Shillong

Morning after breakfast, check out your Hotel and begin your road journey towards Shillong (130 Kms. / 3.5 Hrs.), Enroute visit Umiam Lake or Barapani Lake, the biggest artificial lake in Meghalaya, it offers an incredible experience of sailing & other water sports activities (on direct payment basis) in midst of sylvan hills adorned by Khasi pines & peerless beauty. Arrive Shillong and check into your Hotel. Overnight Stay in Shillong.

DAY 3: Shillong- Dawki- Mawlynnong- Shillong

Drive to Mawlynnong. Visit the cleanest village Mawlynnong in the world. drive to Dawki. Later back to Shillong. Overnight Stay in Shillong.

DAY 4 : Shillong- Cherrapunjee- Guwahati

Guwahati



Guwahati lies between the banks of the Brahmaputra River and the foothills of the Shillong plateau, with LGB International Airport to the west and the town of Narengi to the east. It is gradually being expanded as North Guwahati to the northern bank of the Brahmaputra. The noted Madan Kamdev is situated 30 kilometres (19 mi) from Guwahati. The Guwahati Municipal Corporation (GMC), the city's local government, administers an area of 216 square kilometres (83 sq mi), while the Guwahati Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDA) is the planning and development body of greater Guwahati Metropolitan Area. With an area of 1,528 square kilometres (590 sq mi), Guwahati is the second-largest metropolitan region in eastern India, after Kolkata. [Read less](#)

Shillong



It is the headquarters of the East Khasi Hills district and is situated at an average altitude of 4,908 feet (1,496 m) above sea level, with the highest point being Shillong Peak at 6,449 feet (1,966 m). Shillong is the 330th most populous city in India with population of 143,007 according to the 2011 census. It is said that the rolling hills around the town reminded the European settlers of Scotland. [Read less](#)

The name "cherrapunji" which means 'land of oranges' was first used by tourists from other parts of India. Local taxis also travel to Cherrapunji, and give you the option of stopping at a few viewpoints and sights on the way from Shillong to Cherrapunji (Elephant Falls, Mawkdok Dympep Valley View and others), as well as visiting spots in Cherrapunji (the Mawsmi Cave, Cherrapunji Eco Park, the Nohsngithiang Falls or Seven Sister Falls).
