DETAILED ITINERARY	
Day 1: Arrive Srinagar Welcome to Kashmir: Jannat- E- Firdaus!! Arrive at Srinagar Airport. Meet the local Airport Representative and proceed towards your Houseboat for check in. After you check-in and freshen up, enjoy the famous Shikara ride on Dal Lake. Overnight stay on the Houseboat. Meal: Lunch & Dinner	
Day 2 (07.30 Hrs.): Srinagar - Pahalgam (95 Kms/ Approx 3.5 hrs) Today after an early breakfast, check out and visit Shankaracharya Temple. Located on the Shankaracharya Hill, dedicated to Lord Shiva, it is accessible by 272 steps up the mountain. Visit the Mughal Gardens - Nishat Bagh and Shalimar Bagh. Drive to Pahalgam - Valley of Shepherds. Enroute, stop in Pampore for a demonstration on Saffron cultivation. Also get a chance to buy Kashmiri Saffron. Visit Avantipur ruins -A excavated Temple complex dedicated to Lord Shiva and Vishnu were built by King Avantiraman in 9th century. Later proceed towards your hotel in Pahalgam. Overnight stay in Pahalgam. Meal: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner	
Day 3 (08.00 Hrs.): Pahalgam (Half Day excursion to Aru Valley, Betaab Valley, Chandanwari) After breakfast, visit Aru Valley - offering some fantastic scenes of the lush meadows and mountains. Visit Betaab valley - initially known as the Harjan Valley, this valley was renamed after the hit Bollywood movie Betaab, which was shot in its picturesque surroundings. Visit Chandanwari - starting point for Amarnath Yatra and is a popular hiking destination. Rest of the day is free to stroll in the local market of Pahalgam. Overnight at the hotel in Pahalgam. Note: - Kindly note the Half Day excursion to Aru, Betaab and Chandanwari is done by the Local Taxis (Tavera/ Sumo/ Eeco) which run on a set schedule operated by the local Taxi Union on Pahalgam. Meal: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner	
Day 4 (08.00 Hrs.): Pahalgam - Gulmarg (140 Kms / approx 04 hrs) Today after breakfast, enjoy a picturesque drive to Gulmarg - "Meadow of Flowers". En-route, stop for a picture at the ancient Sun Temple in Martand. Enroute, visit Kashmiri Cricket Bat Factory. Post lunch drive to Gulmarg. Arrive and check-in at hotel. Evening is free to stroll on own. Overnight stay in Gulmarg. Meal: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner	
Day 5 (08.00 Hrs.): Gulmarg - Srinagar (55Kms / approx. 3 Hrs) After Buffet breakfast. Enjoy Asia's Highest Cable Car Project Gulmarg Gondola - The Gondola offers all tourists scenic views of Pir Panjal Mountains and Valley as you head towards Phase 1: KHILANMARG. You may enjoy a Sledge ride or Snow Mobile ride on the snow-covered slopes (on direct payment basis) Later proceed to Srinagar. En-route visit Handloom Emporium. Arrive at Srinagar and Check- in into the Hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Srinagar. Meal: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner	

Day 6 (10.00 Hrs.): Fly Back Home

PLACES COVERED

Srinagar

Srinagar, the summer capital of Jammu & Kashmir, is famous for its serene Dal Lake, vibrant houseboats, and charming Mughal gardens. The city offers a perfect blend of natural beauty, culture, and Kashmiri traditions. The calm shikara rides on Dal Lake, bustling markets, and delicious local cuisine make Srinagar a delightful destination for travellers.

Shankaracharya Temple

The Shankaracharya Temple, located atop Shankaracharya Hill, is one of the oldest and most revered temples in the valley. Dedicated to Lord Shiva, the temple offers a peaceful spiritual environment along with breathtaking panoramic views of Srinagar city and Dal Lake. A climb of around 200 steps leads to the temple, making it a serene and fulfilling experience for devotees and tourists alike.

Shalimar Bagh

Shalimar Bagh is one of the grandest Mughal gardens built by Emperor Jahangir for his wife, Nur Jahan. Set along the banks of Dal Lake, the garden features terraced lawns, flowing water channels, and beautiful fountains. Its traditional Mughal architecture and natural charm make it a popular spot for relaxation, photography, and walks amid nature.

Mughal Garden (Nishat Bagh/Chashme Shahi)

The Mughal Gardens of Srinagar, particularly Nishat Bagh and Chashme Shahi, showcase the elegance and beauty of Mughal landscaping. Nishat Bagh, also known as the "Garden of Bliss," is known for its long terraced layout, while Chashme Shahi is admired for its natural freshwater spring and compact yet beautifully crafted garden area. Both gardens offer picturesque views of the surrounding mountains and Dal Lake.

Pahalgam

Pahalgam, also known as the "Valley of Shepherds," is a scenic hill town surrounded by lush green forests, rivers, and snow-clad peaks. It is a popular base for trekking, nature walks, and river rafting, offering a peaceful escape from city life. The soothing sound of the Lidder River and the charming countryside views make Pahalgam a must-visit destination.

Aru Valley

Gulmarg

Gulmarg, often called the "Meadow of Flowers," is a premier hill station famous for its lush meadows, snow-covered peaks, and adventure activities. It is home to the Gulmarg Gondola, one of the highest cable cars in the world, offering spectacular views of the Himalayas. Gulmarg is also a popular winter destination for skiing, snowboarding, and other snow sports.
